Paint-out Weekend in the beautiful Goulburn River Valley and staying in the little township of Trawool.

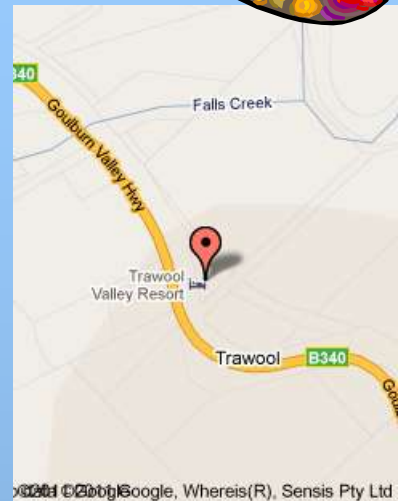
