The final in a series of classes to learn to draw quickly and effectively from wildlife.

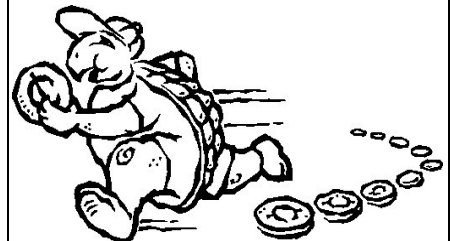
Saturday 10am – 12noon 12th Sept with Velda Palazzi at Melbourne Zoo.
